


Following Point discussed in the meeting:

- (ii) Feedback committee taken an online survey on Teaching & Learning process from 27/04/2022 to 07/05/2022.
- (iii) Committee received Total 565 Students responses.
- (iv) After the analysis, Report submitted to Chairman of feedback committee.
- (v) Chairman discussed on the following Key points responses by students in survey;
  1. A high percentage of students (86.6%) complete satisfaction over the quality of Teaching Learning in our college.
  2. Students have expressed overall satisfaction regarding the syllabus completion and laboratory experiments (93%), preparedness of the teachers (89.8%) and communications with the students (84.9%).
  3. Students have appreciated the teacher's attitude towards teaching and fairness in evaluation. However, they have requested for more concentration on poor performance student and build their confidence.
  4. Teacher's preparation, communication, use of appropriate teaching pedagogy and fairness of internal evaluation has been rated high in the survey.
  5. The college provides ample opportunities for cultural activities, sports activities and extra curricular activities. The teachers also encourage for the participation in extra curricular activities (86.7%). The students have opined that college also provides good environment for emotional growth of students.
  6. The students have expressed satisfaction (86.2%) regarding the mentorship programme, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process run by the institute.
  7. Students appreciated (84.3%) teaching and implementation of learning outcome based curriculum which includes continuous evaluation and assessment of students throughout the semester.
  8. Students have also acknowledged (86.2%) about student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.
- (vi) Chairman discuss the following suggestions by students in survey; with IQAC Committee; concerned Head, Faculties of the department and Librarian and give necessary instructions to them.

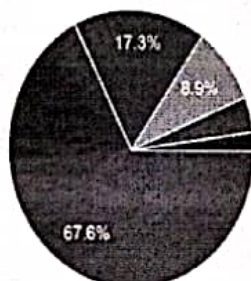

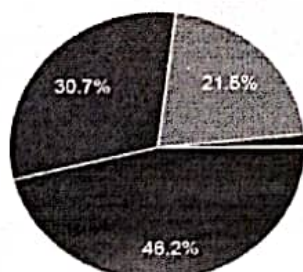

In the session 2021-22, Online Survey is taken from the students regarding suggestions on improvement of the Teaching & Learning Process. We have received 565 students' responses and analyzed.

**Action taken on Student Satisfaction Survey:**

The data was collected and analyzed by Feedback committee. In general, positive feedback was received as majority of the students expressed satisfaction with respect to Teaching & Learning Process of the college. The relevant suggestions were listed out by Feedback committee. The analysis of the feedback was discussed with Chairman. On the basis of the data of analysis report the following findings and suggestions of the survey, Chairman Conducted Meeting on 05/07/2022 and discuss with IQAC Committee; concerned Head; faculties of the department and give necessary instructions to them.

**Key findings from the survey:**

1. A high percentage of students (86.6%) complete satisfaction over the quality of Teaching Learning in our college.
2. Students have expressed overall satisfaction regarding the syllabus completion and laboratory experiments (93%), preparedness of the teachers (89.8%) and communications with the students (84.9%).

3. Students have appreciated the teacher's attitude towards teaching and fairness in evaluation. However, they have requested for more concentration on poor performance student and build their confidence.

4. Teacher's preparation, communication, use of appropriate teaching pedagogy and fairness of internal evaluation has been rated high in the survey.

5. The college provides ample opportunities for cultural activities, sports activities and extracurricular activities. 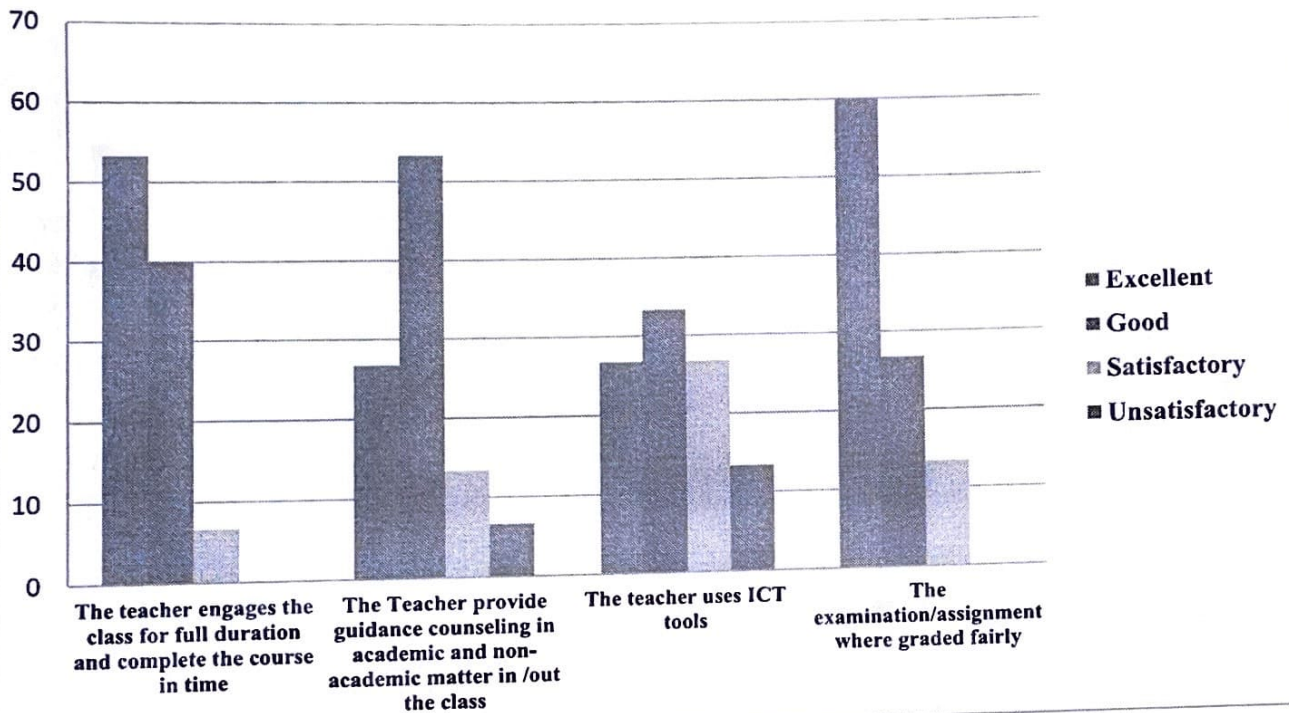

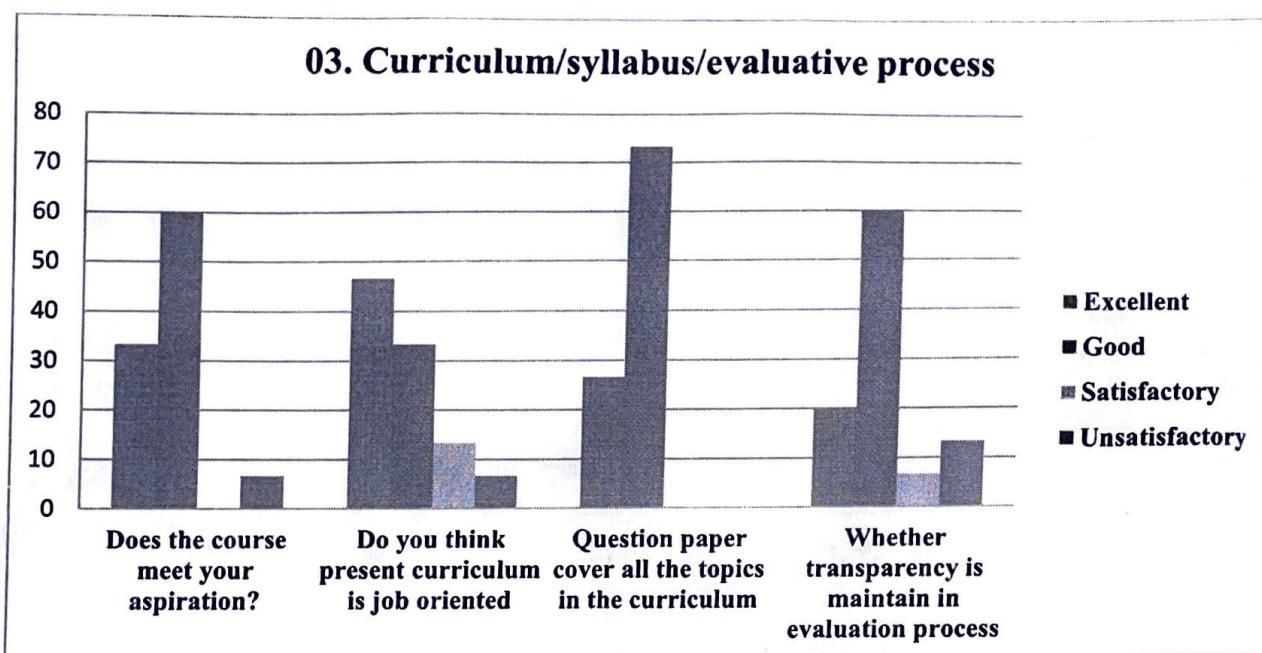

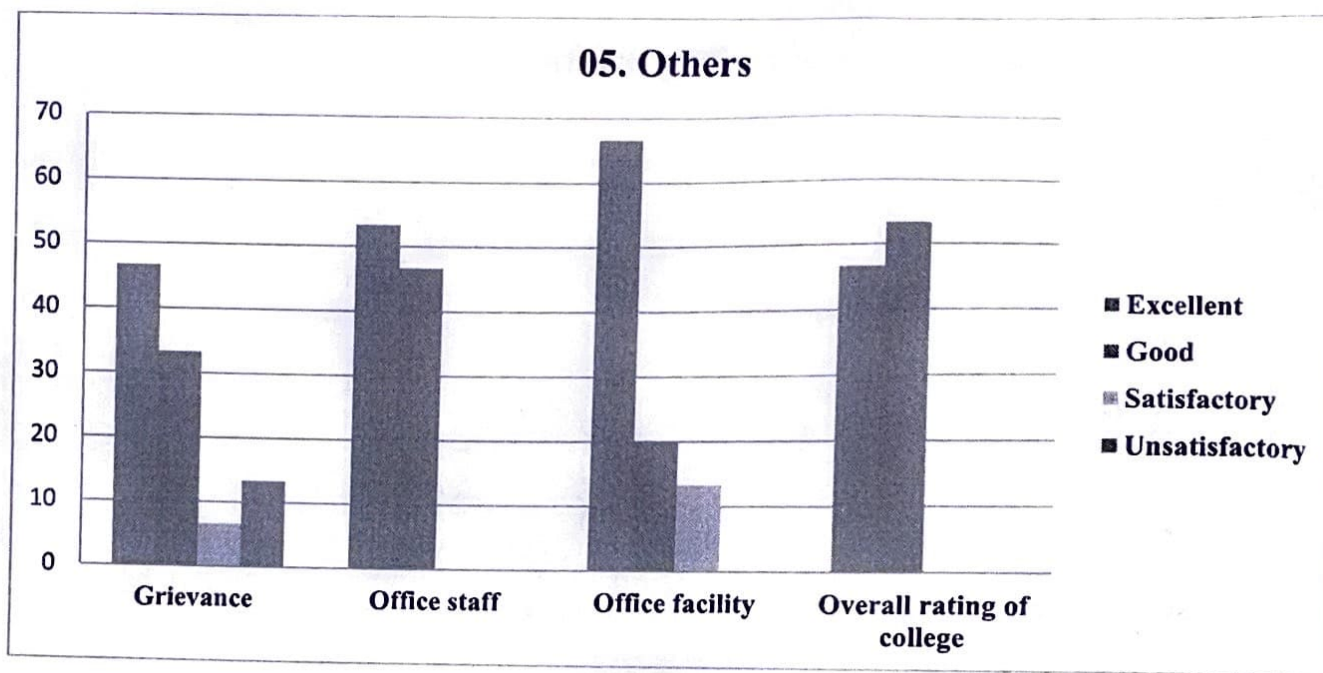

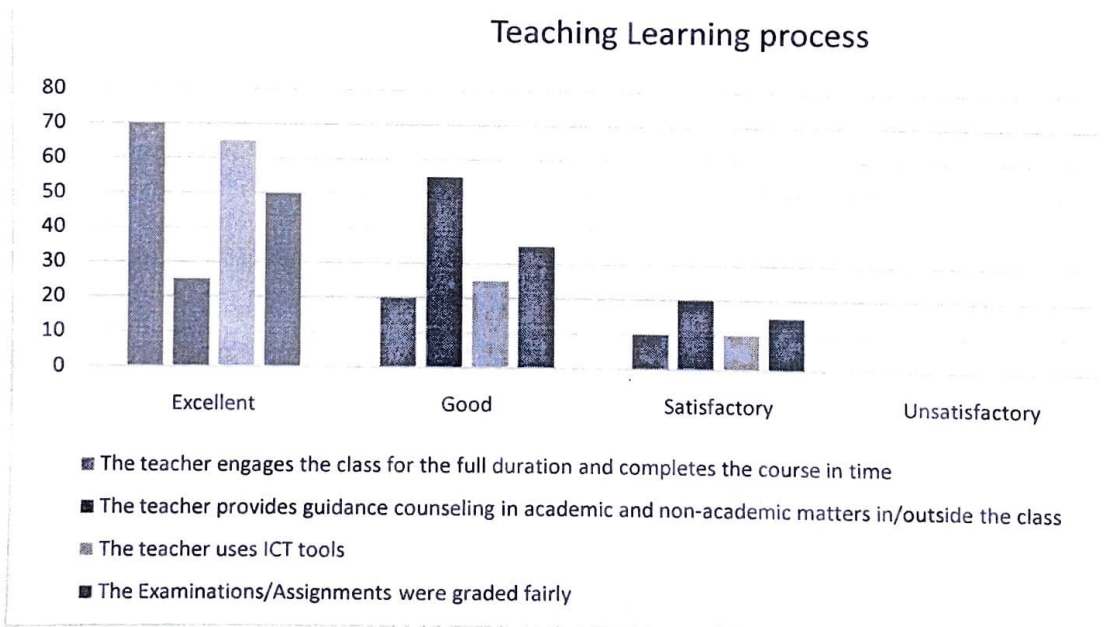

## II. Teaching Learning Process



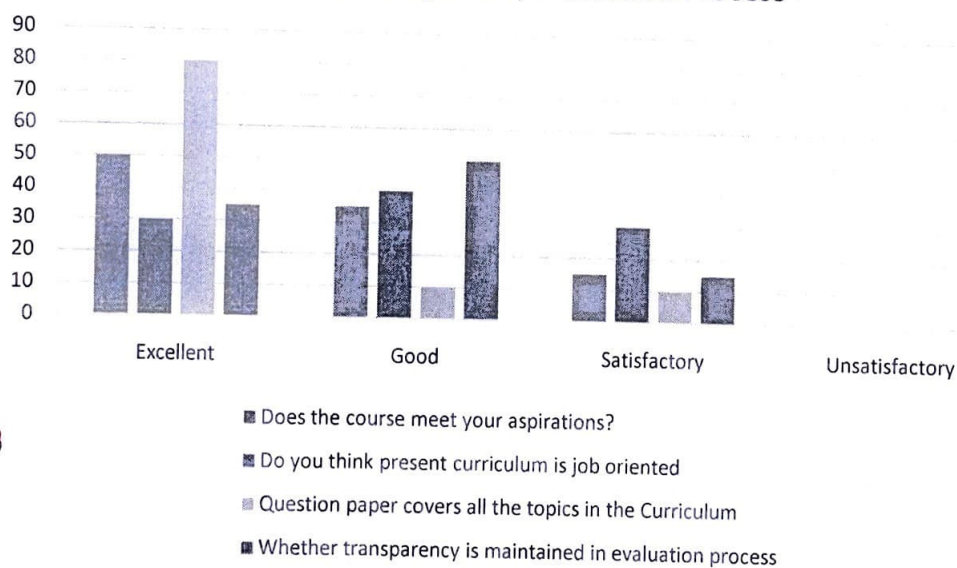
The chart given above shows the information about the teaching learning process. The respondents gave their response in the following way-

Curriculum syllabus/Evaluation Process



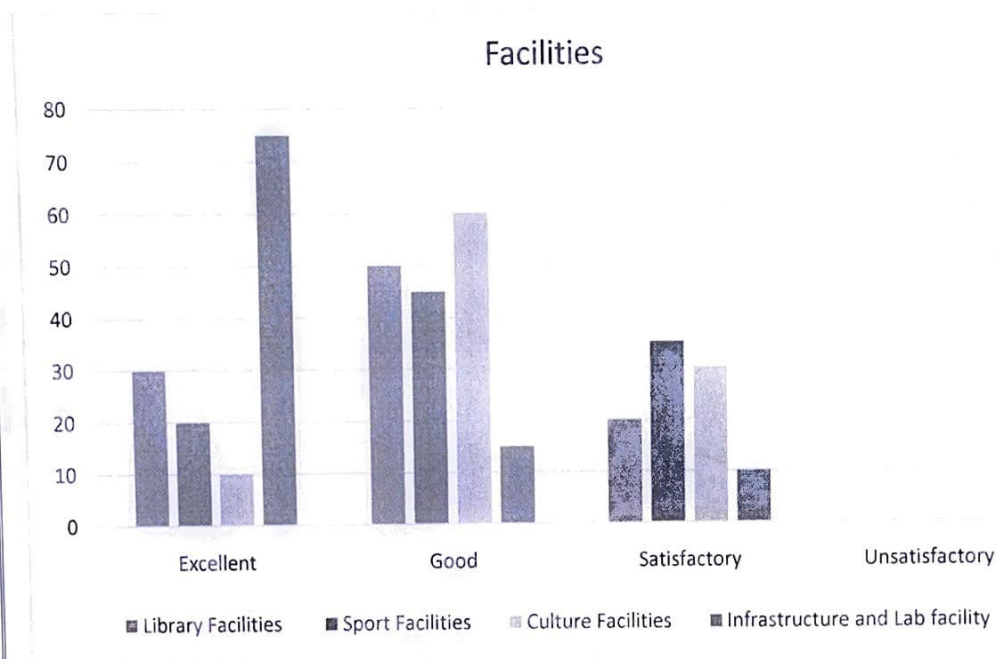
The next point was given to the alumni was about curriculum Syllabus/ Evaluation process. The respondents gave their feedback in the following way.

Sport Facilities:- Excellent (20%) ,Good (45%) ,Satisfactory (35% )

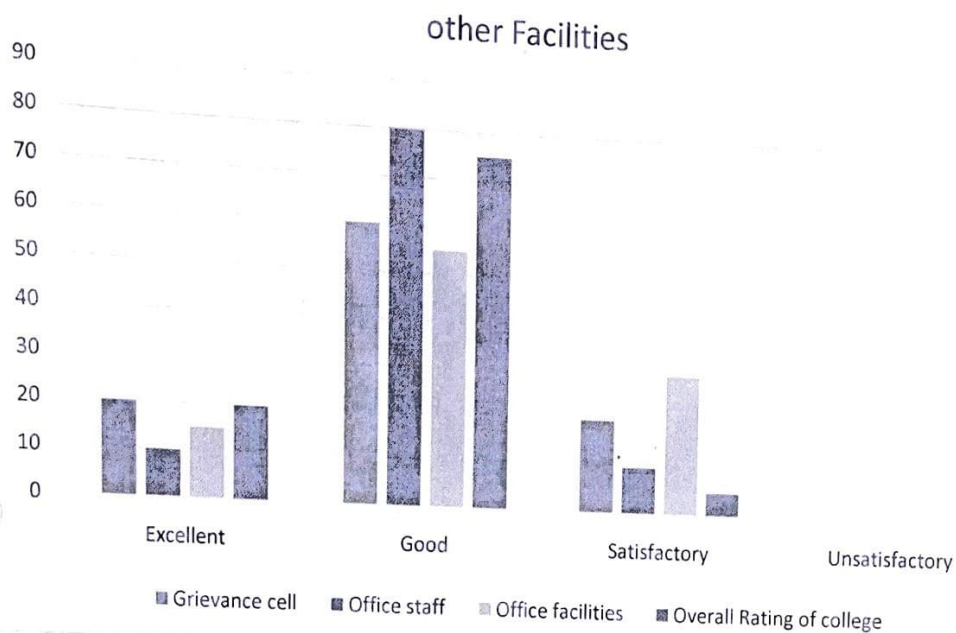
Culture facility :-Excellent (10%) ,Good (60%) and Satisfactory (30% )

The following suggestions can be deduced from the analysis of alumni feedback

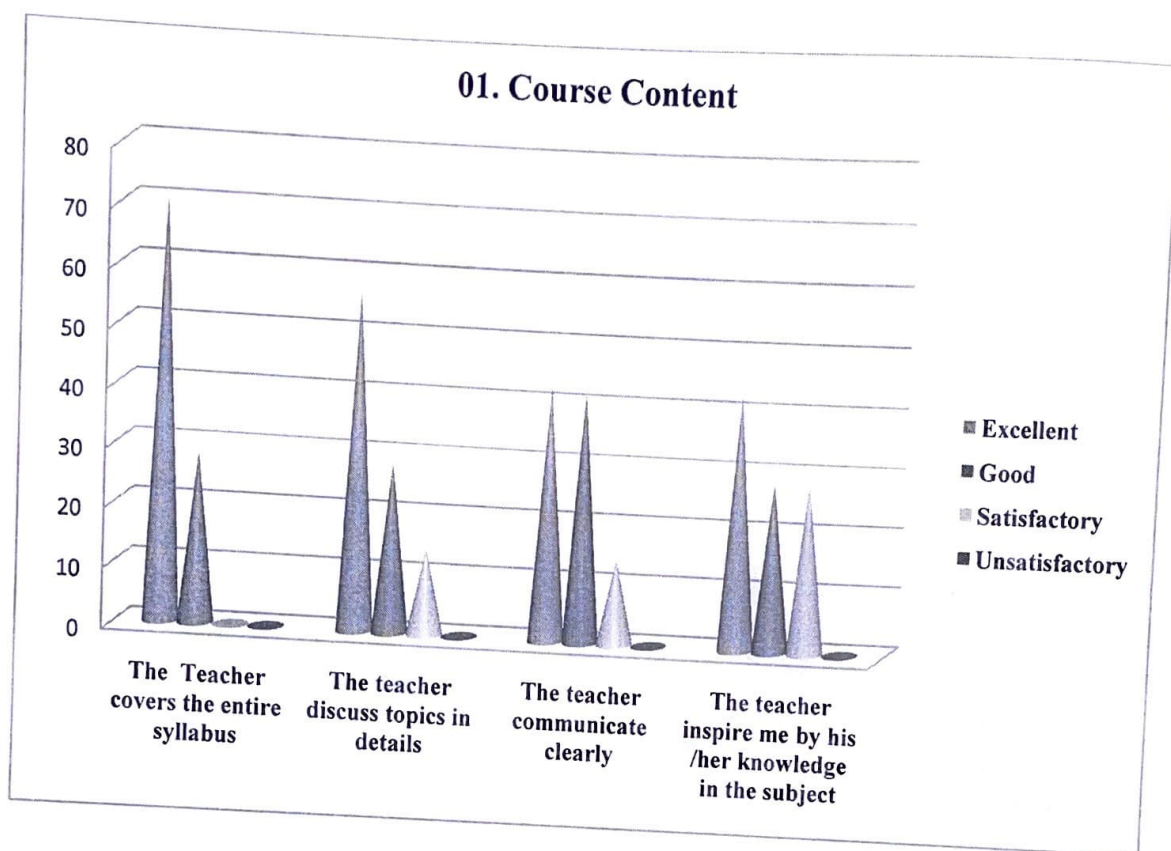

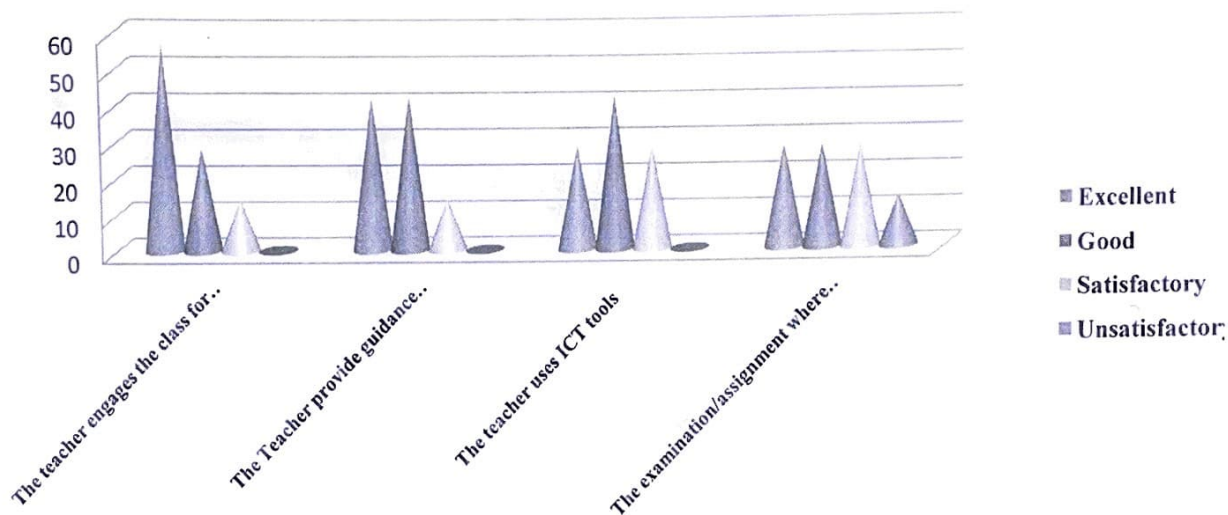

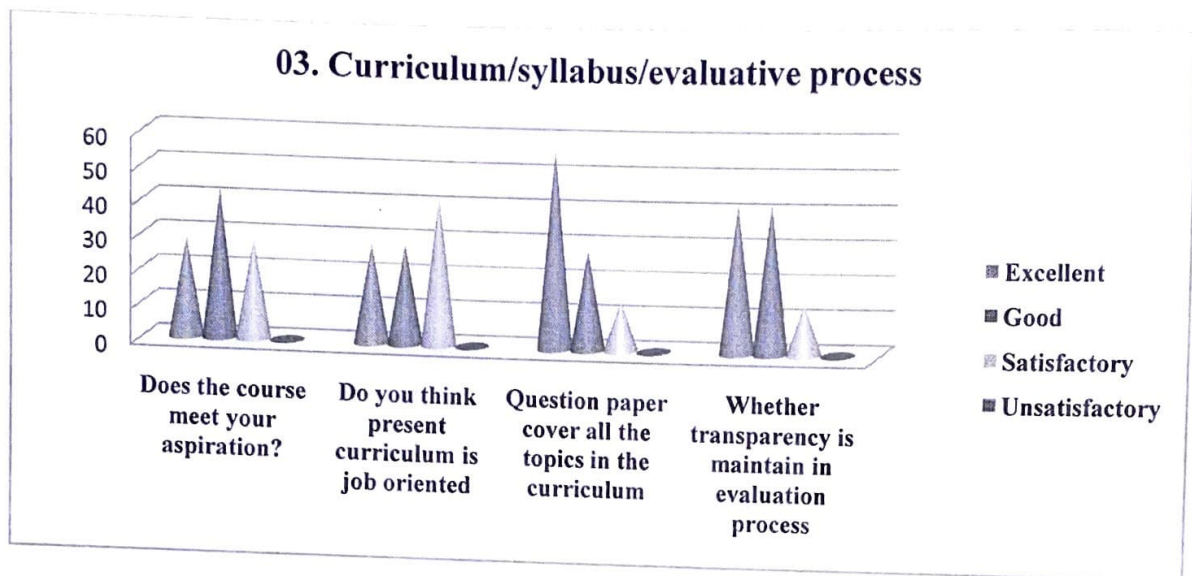

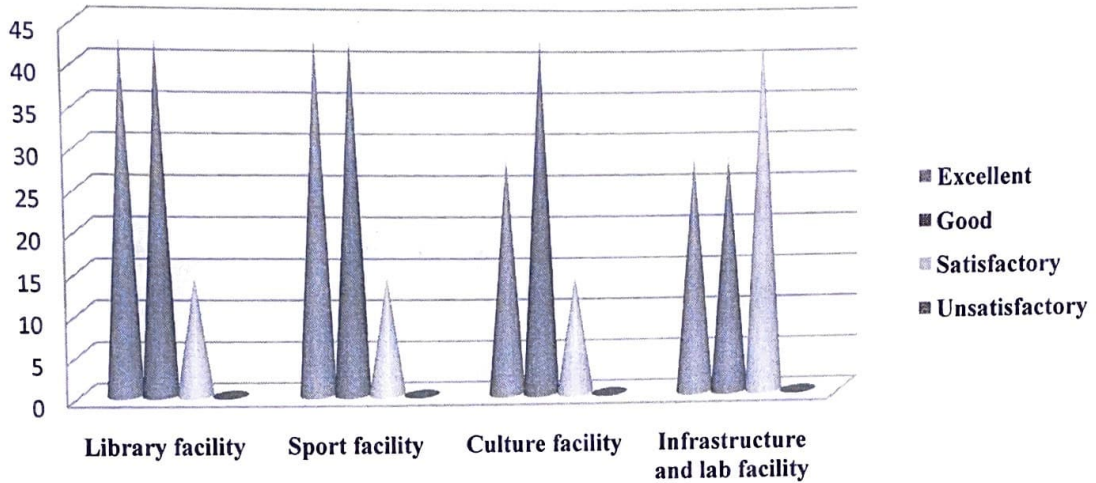

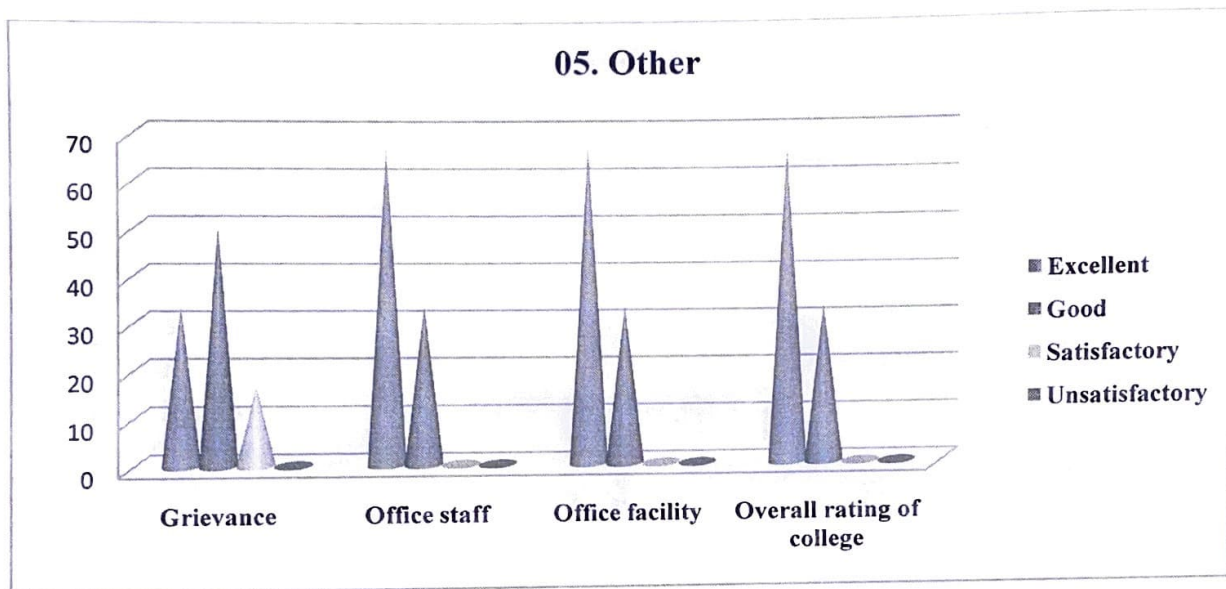
