Key findings from the survey:

- 1. A high percentage of students (86.6%) complete satisfaction over the quality of Teaching Learning in our college.
- 2. Students have expressed overall satisfaction regarding the syllabus completion and laboratory experiments (93%), preparedness of the teachers (89.8%) and communications with the students (84.9%).

- 3. Students have appreciated the teacher's attitude towards teaching and fairness in evaluation. However, they have requested for more concentration on poor performance student and build their confidence.











The following suggestions can be deduced from the analysis of alumni feedback


